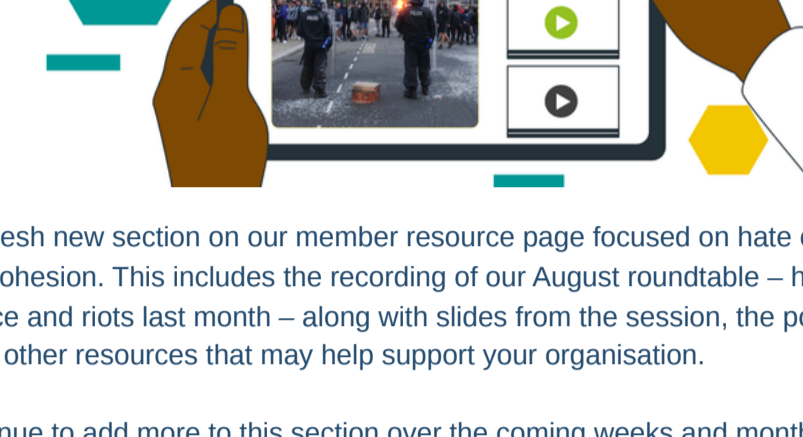

New member resources, including from our August roundtable!

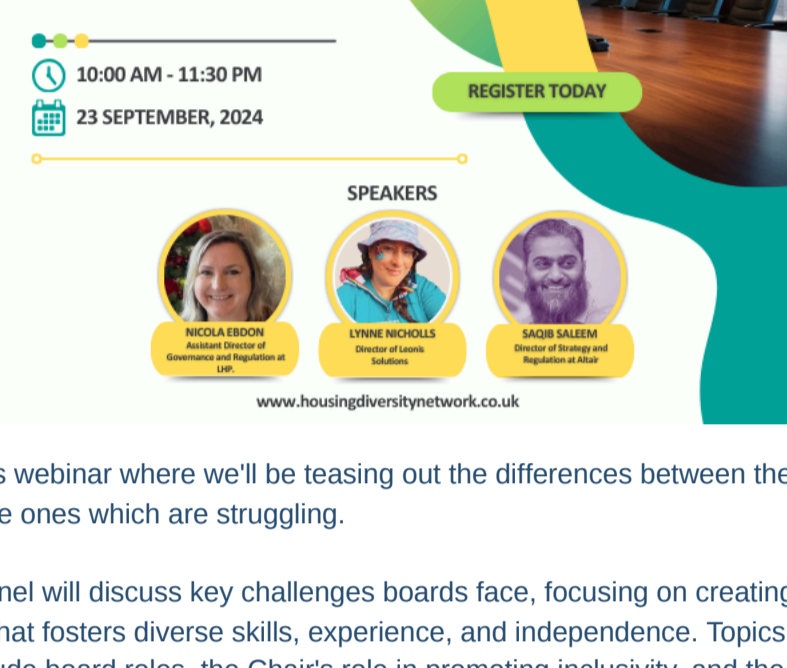

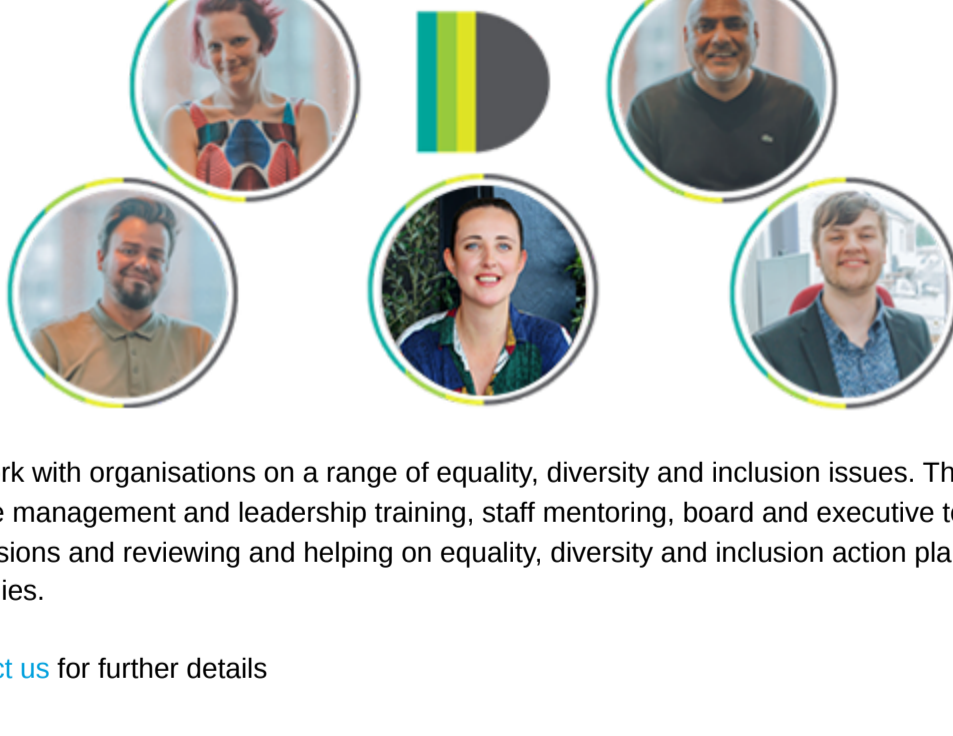
